This page informs you of our policies regarding the collection, use and disclosure of Personal Information we receive from users of the site.

We use your Personal Information only for providing access to and improving the course sites. By using responsivelearning.com, you agree to the collection and use of information in accordance with this policy. We do not sell your personal information to any third party, and we do not share any information about you unless we are required by law to do so.

Information Collection And Use

While using our site, we will ask you to provide us with certain personally identifiable information which is necessary to gain access to and receive credit for our online PD courses. We may use this information to contact and identify you. Personally identifiable information may include, but is not limited to your name, email address, district/campus of employment, and work phone number.

For any credit card purchases, our servicer is PayPal, therefore we do not have access to nor store any credit card information.

Log Data

Like many site operators, we collect information that your browser sends whenever you visit our Site ("Log Data").

This Log Data may include information such as your computer's Internet Protocol ("IP") address, browser type, browser version, the pages of our Site that you visit, the time and date of your visit, other statistics. This data may be referenced if you require technical support.

Email

If you decide to send us an electronic mail message (e-mail), the message will usually contain your return e-mail address. If you include personally-identifying information in your e-mail because you

want us to address issues specific to your situation, we may use that information in responding to your request. Also, e-mail is not necessarily secure against interception. Please send only information necessary to help us process your request. We may use your Personal Information to contact you with newsletters, marketing or promotional materials and other information that may be beneficial to professional development in education.

Cookies

Cookies are files with small amount of data, which may include an anonymous unique identifier. Cookies are sent to your browser from a web site and stored on your computer's hard drive.
